The early ancestors of the family were Merchants, Bakers and cane weavers.

From the book one can readily see that the family had quite a sizeable business and was considered one of the largest in that area. The income from their business must have run into a sizeable figure.

The genealogical chart shows only the lineal line of descent and does not show all of the children of each family. We have shown both sides of the family line because the parents of Carl H. A. were second cousins.

We are most interested in the ancestors of Carl H. A. Van Der Smissen because of his connection to the Ruth family. He married Elizabeth Bertha Ruth, daughter of David B. Ruth and Maria Berger.

We show the lineage of Carl H. A. Van Der Smissen from both the paternal and maternal sides. The first sheet shows the paternal side and the second one the maternal side. Hinrich 3rd. Van Der Smissen married Helena Elizabeth Van Der Smissen, a sister of Jacob Gysbert Van Der Smissen.

Evidently their being of the Mennonite faith and taking their religion seriously made quite a change in this branch of the family, for we find that there were three generations of ministers starting from a son of Jacob Gysbert Van Der Smissen. No doubt, the step mother of Jacob 2nd. Van Der Smissen had quite a bit of influence on him with reference to starting him on the road to being a minister.

The ministers were;

Jacob 2nd. Van Der Smissen.

Carl Justus Van Der Smissen.

Carl H. A. Van Der Smissen.

Carl Justus Van Der Smissen was a book binder and he became a minister of the Mennonite Church in the year of 1837. He came to America in 1868 and died in Hayesville, Ohio on May 29, 1890.

Shortly after that, in 1900, the family moved to Summerfield, Illinois, where after the death of his first wife, Carl H. A. was married to Miss Elizabeth Bertha Ruth on June 18, 1893.

Carl H. A. was minister of the Mennonite Church from 1890 to 1911. He also taught german school and catechism during the summer months. In December 1911 Carl H. A. and his family moved to Berne, Indiana to become editor of several publications of the General Conference Mennonites. He served as secretary of the foreign mission board for fifteen years.

He and his wife entered the Bethel Home for the Aged in October 1932 where they lived until the Lord called them home to their eternal reward.

DEKNATEL; born in Amsterdam in 1750 and died in Altona in 1817.

All the children were born to the first wife.
