JOHN EDWARD RUTH-ANNA MARIE DUECK FAMILY

A SYNOPSIS OF THE LIFE OF

JOHN EDWARD RUTH

AND

ANNA MARIE DUECK

John Edward Ruth was born on the sixteenth day of February 1869 at Summerfield, Illinois. He was a son of David B. Ruth and Maria Berger.

He received his elementary schooling in the area of Summerfield, Illinois and also attended McKendree College. He was especially talented in the field of mechanical engineering, the vocation in which he did a most excellent job. He was Master Mechanic and the consultant for National Enameling and Stamping Company of Granite City, Illinois. He was in charge of the design and manufacture of all the necessary dies and equipment needed to carry on the manufacture of their product. This included many intricate and complicated dies and fixtures which he designed.

As consultant he traveled to the several branches of this Company to discuss the manufacturing methods and tooling requirements needed for any new products that the Company hoped to place on the market along with the feasibility of its production in quantity.

Granite City received its name through the great amount of granite ware that was being manufactured in that area. Granite ware in its day, was a boon to the housewife much the same as the aluminum and the stainless steel ware which took its place, is in the

present day. At this writing you find but little, if any, of this granite or enameled ware. Its one great fault was that it could not stand much impact shock. In cases where the utensil received a severe bump or shock, the enamel would chip off and leave the bare metal exposed and subjected to rust along with the possibility of small pieces of the granite chipping off and getting into the food.

As a youngster when attending college he was sent home because he dared disagree with some theory that the professor tried to teach him, saying that it was impractical and would not work in practice. A letter written by this professor and sent to John's father conveyed the information that John was too dumb to attend college, would never make an engineer and was to be kept at home. His accomplishments and records with the Stamping Company proved the professor to be in error in his judgement of John's ability.

On the twenty-eighth of June in the year of 1902 he was united in marriage with Miss Anna Marie Dueck and the couple made their home in Granite City. This union was blest with three children, two boys and a girl. Their first child, a boy, died at the age of a little over one month.

Some time after Mr. Ruth complained of illness he and the family moved to Beatrice, Nebraska hoping that the change in environment would be instrumental in regaining his health but such was not to be the case and his condition continued to grow more complicated until on August the tenth, 1918 when he was taken to his eternal reward. His earthly remains lie buried in the Mennonite Cemetery near the city of Beatrice, Nebraska.

His widow is still living at this writing. She is one of two of the only living members of this branch and generation of the Ruth Family through marriage. The other is her sister Marie, the widow of Samuel David Ruth, a brother of John Edward.

HENRY J. KREHBIEL-LYDIA D. RUTH FAMILY

A SYNOPSIS OF THE LIFE OF

HENRY J. KREHBIEL
AND
LYDIA D. RUTH

Henry J. Krehbiel was born in the vicinity of the village of Donnellson, Iowa on September the ninth, in the year of 1865. He was the sixth child of Rev. Jacob E. Krehbiel and Katherine Ruth.

Jacob E. Krehbiel was a son of Johannes Krehbiel and Katherine Krehbiel of Weierhof. Both he and his parents were born in Weierhof and lived there until in the year of 1844. On Easter Sunday of that year, the family migrated to Kleinschwabenhausen in Upper Bavaria where they lived until in 1851 when they all migrated to America. They made their home in Ashland County, Ohio for six months, then they moved to Lee County, Iowa where they bought a farm which remained the family home until the father died in 1859. After that, the two elder brothers, Jacob E. and Christian and their younger brother Valentine along with their mother, moved to Summerfield, Illinois.

Four brothers in this family chose four women of the Ruth Family for their partners in life, namely; Jacob E. Krehbiel married Katherine Ruth. Christian Krehbiel married Susanna Ruth. Johannes Krehbiel married Katherine Ruth. Valentine Krehbiel married Susanna Ruth.

Henry J. went to McKendree College in Lebanon and then to the Evangelical Seminary in Saint Louis. He was ordained as minister in September of the year of 1892. On the twenty fifth day of May in the year of 1893, he was united in Holy Matrimony with Lydia D. Ruth of Summerfield, Illinois.

A short time thereafter, he received and accepted a call from the Mennonite Congregation at Trenton,

Ohio and the couple made their home there. He served this Congregation for seventeen years. Four of their children were born there. Their fifth child, Arthur, was born in Reedley, California.

In the year of 1907, he took a leave of absence and made a trip to Europe with his mother and one of his sisters. In this same year, he went to Reedley, California for a short visit and preached to a small Mennonite Congregation that was located there. They were holding their meetings in the Washington School House. In March of the year of 1908, the family went back to Trenton, Ohio. Shortly thereafter, Reverend Henry J. Krehbiel received and accepted a call from the Reedley Congregation and served them for a total of eighteen years. He was forced to cut down on his numerous duties connected with the church due to his failing health.

To commemorate his long and faithful service, the Congregation invited the General Conference to hold their session in Reedley in the year of 1917. It was the first Conference session to be held in a western State. In 1925, he was elected as a delegate to the General Conference, an organization of which he was president at the time, in Basel, Switzerland for the purpose of celebrating the 400th. anniversary of the Mennonite Denomination. This conference was held in June of the year of 1925.

After his return, he wrote a Brochure entitled "A trip through Europe and a plea for the abolition of war", a portion of which was printed by the General Conference. They set aside a fund to cover printing 5000 copies and handed them out as a tract.

In the year of 1930, he and his wife made a trip to Bluffton, Ohio to attend the graduation exercises of their son Walter. The College bestowed the title of "Doctor of Divinity" upon him. It was done as an honor and a memorial for his thirty years of work in connection with the founding of this school and also his work in connection with the General Conference.

He served as president of the General Conference for two terms and also in other capacities. He served as president of the Mennonite Publications. His work in the field of religion was known far and wide. He was well known throughout the United States and Canada.

In the summer of 1932, the family held a festival of rejoicing, about which he wrote an article on the recollections of bygone times. He passed away on the fifth day of October in the year of 1940 at Reedley, California. He was highly respected and esteemed by the Community as a whole and they will miss him and his good work and faithful service.

He was survived by his widow, five children; Paul G., Ruth M. (Mrs. Leslie Jacobs), Robert D., Walter H. and Arthur J., a brother Daniel E., two sisters, Mrs. Susie Ringelmann and Miss Clara Krehbiel and a host of relatives and friends.

LYDIA D. RUTH

Lydia D. Ruth was born near Summerfield, Illinois on the seventh day of December in the year of 1870. She was the seventh child of David B. Ruth and Maria Berger. She joined the Mennonite Church in her youth and grew to womanhood in the Summerfield area.

David B. Ruth was a son of Jacob Ruth and Barbara Strohm. Jacob was born in Harxheim an der Pfrimm in the Palatinate. In the fall of the year of 1819, his father, together with his family, migrated to Upper Bavaria to a farm named "Eichstock". Here Jacob grew to manhood, married Barbara Strohm and made his home in Harreszell where all of their children were born. In 1852 the family, with the exception of the father who died in Harreszell in 1848, migrated to America, first making their home in Lee County, Iowa and then at Summerfield, Illinois. Barbara remained a widow until shortly before the family migrated to America, at which time she was married to John Kraemer. There were no children born to this union.

Lydia D. Ruth and Reverend Henry J. Krehbiel were united in Holy Matrimony on the twenty fifth day of May in the year of 1893. Reverend Krehbiel had been ordained as a minister about a year previously. Soon after their marriage, they moved to Trenton, Ohio to serve the Mennonite Congregation located there. They served this Congregation for seventeen years.

In the winter of the year of 1908 the couple went to Reedley, California and visited the Congregation located there. A short time later, they received and accepted a call from this Congregation and moved to Reedley where they made their home for the remainder of their lives.

In the year of 1925 they made a trip to Europe to visit Switzerland, Germany, Belgium, Holland, Italy, France and England in conjunction with attending the Conference celebrating the 409th. anniversary of the Mennonite Denomination. This conference was held on June the thirteenth to sixteenth, 1925.

The couple was blessed with one daughter and four sons, each child being born in a different home. The wife stood faithfully by her husband in the diligent and endless struggle in connection with the work of the church. The Lord was exceptionally good to them, blessing them for their work in the church, much the same as he blessed their family. They were thankful to the Lord for their many and bountiful blessings.

In January 1944, she was taken ill while visiting her daughter, Ruth Jacobs in Los Angeles, and stayed there until the Lord called her home. On the twenty fifth of June 1944, she was released from all of her earthly troubles and her wish to meet her Creator in Heaven was fulfilled. The survivors are; besides her daughter, Ruth Jacobs, four sons with a family, Paul of Woodlake, Walter and Arthur of Reedley and Robert of Trenton, Missouri; and two brothers, Henry Albert Ruth of Halstead, Kansas and David Samuel of Summerfield, Illinois.
