A SYNOPSIS OF THE LIFE OF

Roy Philip Lehman was born on a farm seven miles north of Halstead, Kansas on the eighteenth day of September in the year of 1901. He was a son of David Benjamin Lehmann and Margaret Anna Blough.

Roy spent his boyhood days on the farm, attending Harvey County District # 43 (Garden Valley) School and graduating in the year of 1914. He attended the University of Kansas 1919 to 1923, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Geology.

He taught school in Wallace, Kansas from 1923 to 1924. He began his geological work in Oklahoma doing field work for the Indian Territory Illuminating Oil Company from the year 1924 until 1926. Also did some field geological work for the Atlantic Oil Producing Company in the year of 1926. Engaged in doing some geological field mapping for the Phillips Petroleum Company in Oklahoma and Kansas from the year 1927 to 1929 and for the Sinclair Oil and Gas Company in the same States from the year 1929 until 1931, then some geological work in Tyler and Athens, Texas until in the late spring of the year of 1931.

Operated a filling station at Coffeyville, Kansas during the summer of the year of 1931. Was employed by the Sinclair Oil and Gas Company from the latter

part of the year of 1931 and the early part of 1932 as a District Geologist, doing sub-surface and field work in the northeastern part of Colorado. Returned to Wichita, Kansas to do some consulting geological and leasing work from the year of 1932 until 1934.

Returned to the employ of the Phillips Petroleum Company in the year of 1934 and did field mapping in Wichita, Kansas for a period of two years and then was transferred to Shawnee, Oklahoma as sub-surface geologist in the year of 1936 and District Geologist from the year of 1937 until 1945, transferred back to Wichita, Kansas in the year of 1945 as a District Geologist until in the year of 1947.

At the time of this writing he is the Assistant Division Manager and District Geologist for the Land and the Geological Department of the Wichita, Kansas Division of the Phillips Petroleum Company, having a continuous employment record with them from the year of 1934 until the year of 1957.

Freda Augusta Schlender was born at their family home located two miles west of Moundridge, Kansas on the twenty eighth day of July in the year of 1900. She was a daughter of Fredrick August Schlender and Lydia Marie Kittel.

She attended the Harvey County District School, (North Garden) # 51, graduating in the year of 1914. Attended the Moundridge High School and graduated in the year of 1918. Attended at Emporia State Teachers College and at Kansas Agricultural College for one year and then taught school at Shallowwater, Kansas and Moundridge, Kansas.

She finished her college education at the North Central (Evangelical) College located at Naperville, Illinois and graduated in 1926 with a B.A. degree in English and Education and then taught Kindergarten during the years of 1926 and 1927 in the McPherson, Kansas, City Schools.

Roy P. Lehman and Freda A. Schlender were married at Halstead, Kansas on the fifth day of June in the

year of 1927. They first made their home in Norman, Oklahoma from 1927 to 1928, moving to Kansas in 1928 and residing at Russell, Utica and Osborne, Kansas. They returned to Norman, Oklahoma in the early part of 1929 and later that same year returned to Kansas to live at Utica and later at Ellis until in 1930.

Mary Ann was born on the twenty ninth day of the month of August in the year of 1930 at St. Anthony's Hospital at Hays, Kansas. Late in 1930 they moved to Medicine Lodge, Kansas and lived there until early in 1931, when they moved to Texas for a short period of work and lived in Athens and Tyler, Texas. Moved back to Kansas, spending the summer of 1931 in the city of Coffeyville and later in that year moved to Greeley, Colorado, returning to Wichita again in the year of 1932, remaining there until in the spring of 1934 and then moved to Chickasha, Oklahoma. Later in 1934 they moved to Geray, Oklahoma and in the winter of that year moved to Sulphur, Oklahoma. Then early in 1935 they moved to Holdenville, Oklahoma, moving to McAlester, Oklahoma late in spring. Doris Ruth, our second daughter, was born in McAlester, Oklahoma in the Albert Pike Hospital on the twenty fifth day of August in the year of 1935. They left McAlester and moved to Shawnee, Oklahoma in the spring of 1936 and stayed there until in 1945. From here they moved to Wichita, Kansas in 1945 and have been residents of Wichita from 1945 to the present time.

August Henry Lehmann was born the twenty eighth day of January 1865 at Summerfield, Illinois. He was in this area until the age of 16 when he went to the State of Kansas with his parents when they went west to make their new home in Halstead.

Mr. Lehmann was a Merchant in Halstead and he and John Lehmann were in business together. On a later date he bought into a Wholesale Dry Goods House that was located in Wichita, Kansas. The place was known as the Hauser Garrison Wholesale House. At that time Mr. Lehmann moved to Wichita, Kansas.

August Henry Lehmann married Katherine Hux on the seventeenth day of July in the year 1894. They were married in Halstead, Kansas.

Katherine Hux was born on the twenty second day of November in the year of 1871 at Walpool, Ontario, Canada. Her parents were born in Germany and moved to Canada to make their home. After the death of the father the widow and three daughters moved to Kansas and made their home in Halstead. Katherine was the youngest of the three daughters.

The couple resided in Halstead until in 1914 when they moved to Wichita. Mr. Lehmann passed away the twenty eighth of October 1944. Mrs. Lehmann passed away on the nineteenth day of July in the year 1936.

Their earthly remains lie buried in the Halstead Cemetery at Halstead, Kansas.
