

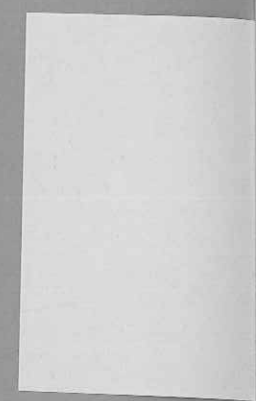

A SYNOPSIS OF THE LIFE OF

JACOB ERNST RUTH

AND

CHRISTINE RISSER

Jacob Ernst Ruth was born in Bavaria on November the twenty sixth, 1848. He came to the United States in a sailing vessel with his parents on their way to a new home in Iowa at the age of three and one half years. They came over in the fall of 1852 and lived in Iowa until in the spring of 1867 when they moved to a new location at Summerfield, Illinois. He lived here for some time before and after his marriage. In 1873 he was united in marriage with Christine Risser of Ohio and the couple made their home near Summerfield, Illinois. Their first child, Augusta Julia, was born August 2, 1874. Six months later they moved to Halstead, Kansas where two more children came to bless their home, Jona A., born on May 15, 1876 and Elma E., born on October 16, 1881. Here at Halstead J. E. Ruth was engaged in Construction work with his brother David C.. In the year of 1874 with 130 men they built 69 homes in 45 days, most of them 20 by 30 feet. These were for housing the immigrants from Russia who settled in the southwest corner of Marion County and formed the town of Alexanderwohl.

This group of immigrants consisted of Mennonites that left Holland for Prussia and then moved to the Russian Crimea. This group held their identity as a Community through all of its migrations and came to America in 1874. Two ships were used to bring the 90 families that were known as the Alexanderwohl group to the United States. The Congregation was organized

in 1660 and is still active in Kansas. It is located one half mile east and one mile north of Goessel, on Highway K-15. The reason for which these people were known as the Alexanderwohl group is as follows. When this group of Mennonites were leaving Russia for the United States, Alexander, Czar of Russia, sent them his best wishes. To return the salutation of friendship, the group expressed themselves, "Alexander, we wish you well." Translated into the native tongue of the German, the phrase is "Alexander, Wohl."

Later he engaged in the hardware business in both Halstead and Moundridge for about thirteen years. He served as City Councilman and a member of the School Board in Halstead. In 1895? In 1855 he moved to Newton where he was employed as bookkeeper in the Warkentin Mill. He later moved to Kingfisher, Oklahoma and became a partner and manager of the Oklahoma Milling Company. In 1898 he bought the mill and proceeded to develop its business and in 1918, built a new mill which was one of the most modern in Oklahoma. He was president of the Oklahoma Millers Association for a number of years and was very active in milling circles of the new State.

In 1907 his wife died after a short illness and was taken to Halstead, Kansas for burial. In 1912 he married Augusta Krehbiel of Reedley, California. In 1914 they took a trip to Europe and visited the old Homestead of Eichstock. He found it to be so much of a show place that colored picture postcards were on sale. Quite a number of these are in the possession of this branch of the family. His second wife passed away in 1919. He continued with the milling business until in 1925 when he retired and moved to McPherson to make his home with Mr. and Mrs. W. J. Krehbiel, Mrs. Krehbiel being his daughter Augusta Julia.

Because of his desire not to be inactive after he retired, he assisted in the business office work of a newspaper, "The Republican." He always took a keen interest in music and for over sixty years conducted

church choirs and some other musical organizations. He was the director of the Male Chorus and the Male Quartet and assistant director of the Newton Musical Union for a number of years when these organizations were prominent in Kansas musical affairs, doing some composing and development of musical talent in the State of Oklahoma. As long as his strength permitted he was a member of the choir of the Congregational Church of McPherson, Kansas, to which he transferred his membership on moving to this city. He was also an ardent follower of sports events, for years never failing to attend the various games and contests in this line of which he was very fond. He had a wide circle of friends in the Communities in which he resided and was liked by everyone.

He wrote the story covering the trip made by this family when they immigrated from Bavaria that begins when they left their Old Homestead at Eichstock and ends when they arrived at their destination in Iowa. He also made an English translation of "The history of the Ruth Family" written in the old German by his father and mother. He also translated and clarified a history and genealogy of the Strohm family that it was possible to include it in our records, since the Strohm Family is well represented in the Ruth Family through marriage.

After an illness of about one year standing he passed on to his eternal reward at the home of his daughter on the tenth of August, 1935. He was up and around the house and was confined to his bed for the last two days only. He reached the age of 86 years, 8 months and 15 days, the last surviving member of a large family, eight of whom lived to be over seventy years of age. He was survived by two daughters, Mrs. W. J. Krehbiel of McPherson, Mrs. C. B. Pfeiffer of Helena, Montana, and Mrs. J. A. Ruth of Los Angeles, the widow of the son who preceded him in death, also seven grandchildren and two great grandchildren. His remains lie buried in the Halstead Kansas Cemetery.

WILLIAM JOHN KREHBIEL-AUGUST, JULIA RUTH FAMILY

A SYNOPSIS OF THE LIFE OF  
WILLIAM JOHN KREHBIEL  
AND  
AUGUSTA JULIA RUTH

William John Krehbiel was born on the eleventh of December, 1870 at Denmark, Iowa, a son of John Jacob Krehbiel and Anna Leisy.

When he was nine years of age he moved to Newton, Kansas with his parents where he attended elementary and high school after which he attended Kansas University. Shortly after his seventeenth birthday he conducted a carriage painting shop in Moundridge for six months and in the early winter became bookkeeper for the Newton Daily Republican at \$4.00 per week. At twenty five he became foreman for Arthur Capper at \$7.00 per week and shortly there-after he became telegraph editor at \$12.00 per week. Two years later he bought the Newton Daily Republican which he owned and operated for eighteen months after which he sold it and in 1899 he bought and published the McPherson Daily Republican and continued active management for a number of years until in 1944 when he retired and sold the paper to one of his sons.

On the twenty fifth of April, 1900 he was united in marriage with Miss Augusta Julia Ruth, a daughter of Jacob Ernst Ruth and Christine Risser. This union was blest with three children; Kenneth R., Marion R. and Ruth Katharine.

Mr. Krehbiel was very active in civic affairs and served two terms as mayor of McPherson, from 1903 to 1906, and one term as State senator from the twenty fourth district of McPherson and Harvey Counties.

Mr. Krehbiel was the compiler and publisher of a history and genealogy of one branch of the Krehbiel family, bringing their old record up to the year of 1950. He also supplied the compiler with some data on other branches of the Krehbiel family that have a connection with the Ruth family through marriage.

Mr. Krehbiel passed away suddenly on May 1, 1957, at his home in McPherson. Funeral services were held at the Congregational Church in McPherson and burial of his earthly remains was at McPherson, Kansas.

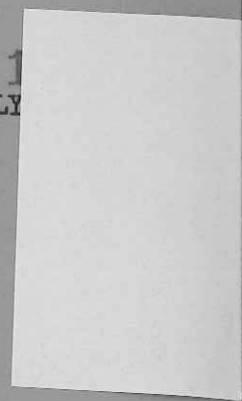
