This *Mennonite Bibliography* is published annually in the April issue of *Mennonite Life*. It contains a list of significant books, pamphlets, and articles that deal with Mennonite life and principles. The magazine articles are restricted to non-Mennonite publications since the historical libraries of Bethel College, North Newton, Kansas; Goshen College, Goshen, Indiana; Bluffton College, Bluffton, Ohio; and the Mennonite Biblical Seminary, Chicago, Illinois; keep complete files of all Mennonite periodicals and publications. — The bibliography for 1946 appeared in the April issue, 1947.
