SUNDAY SERVICES

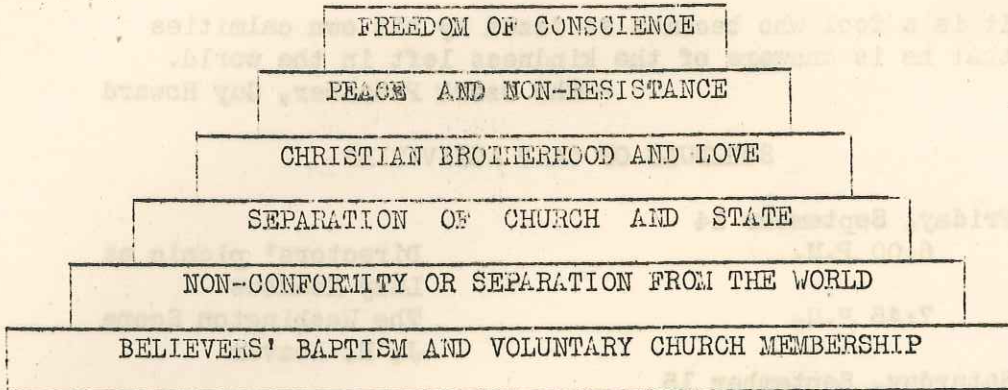
